## TWO JUDGES HONORED AT ANNUAL RED MASS EVENT

The 'red' in Red Mass is derived from the use of the color red for all being indicative of the tongues of fire observed on Pentecost according to the event's program. The Red Mass in the Diocese of San Bernardino began in 1991. Over the years, it has alternated between San Bernardino and Riverside.
